## **IFTAR PROGRAMME**

“Whoever gives food to a fasting person to break his fast will have a reward like his without decreasing his reward in the slightest way.” (Tirmidhi)

### **SOUTHEAST ASIA**

#### **Malaysia**

Our team from Global Ehsan Relief Malaysia went to Kuala Lumpur to visit the Rohingya refugee children. There were a total of **220** children, where **80** of them are orphans. Our GER team was at Madrasah Hashimiah where they interacted with the beautiful and adorable children there. Those children are from refugee families who have fled from Myanmar and have taken refuge in Malaysia. They have no access to education and healthcare. As such, with your support and contributions, we were able to provide them with iftar and distributed eid gifts and goodie bags too.



#### **Indonesia**

In Indonesia, the team had Iftar with the beautiful orphans that we have been sponsoring for years. Your generous contributions have provided them with essential monthly aid like food, shelter and most importantly, education. This Ramadhan, **150** orphans, along with their guardians and remaining parent, were invited for an iftar buffet at Grand Permatahati Hotel. They were also given eid gifts and goodie bags.





## Cambodia

Our team from Cambodia organised an Iftar session in Kandal province at Madrasah Nurul Iman with the orphans and less fortunate female students there. **270** students turned up to share the blessings. Another Iftar was done in Tangha village, Dambae commune, Tboung Khmom district, Tboung Khmom province, benefiting about **350** poor and needy. At Seihanok province, **200** poor and needy received iftar meals which which was funded by you and another **60** beneficiaries supported by Cambodians.





## Singapore

In Singapore, an annual mass Iftar was organised at Al-Amin Mosque. **500** people benefited from this event, including all staff and volunteers, and partners. Our team helped in the preparation with the mosque team leading. Alhamdulillah, your contributions have filled the stomachs of those who are fasting.

Another local project was the daily iftar meal boxes prepared and delivered to the most needy islandwide during Ramadhan. Among the recipients are the elderly, disabled and those who are unable to cook for iftar. The meal boxes comprise of rice, gravy, meat, vegetables, fruits and packet drinks. A total of **5000** beneficiaries benefitted from this project.



## Sri Lanka

Hundreds of students in Al-Aman Arabic College benefited from the Iftar organised by Global Ehsan Relief Sri Lanka. As you might have known, feeding a fasting person is like gaining the rewards of that person too.



## WAKAF

### Indonesia

There are about 60,000 visually impaired people registered just in Aceh alone. Due to their condition, most of them are from low income families and cannot afford to purchase a braille Quran. Like us, they too yearn to read and memorise the Quran. 500 of them received the Quran Braille in a ceremony attended by the Mayor of Aceh. The set also contains a digital pen so that they can listen to the recitation to aid their memorisation as well.





**145** sets of Quran distributed at Mahad Nurul Huda and Mahad Ar-Rahwah, Aceh besar. And another distribution of **300** Quran, as well as Iftar program with more than 1000 students from Mahad Al Bahjah in Cirebon, West Java. A wakaf program that brings immense rewards to both the beneficiaries and donors.





## CLOTHES DISTRIBUTION

### Indonesia

50 sets of prayer mat and kain sarung, and 71 sets of Eid clothes for children were distributed in Scavenger's village in Aceh. The Indonesian team also brought 45 orphans to the department store to get them new clothes in preparation for Eid.



## Singapore

Our Singapore team sponsored **60** kids and adult Hari Raya outfits to the less-fortunate families in Singapore. These families, unlike most of us, are unable to afford and do not have the privilege of donning a new pair of outfit for Hari Raya each year. This year, we managed to bless them with brand new outfits so that they were able to enjoy the festive season together with their loved ones.

## Cambodia

In Cambodia, **100** sets of new prayer garments and jubah for women and men were distributed in Tropeng Lerk village, Takeo province. **120** sets of new uniform for children were also distributed.





## FOOD AID SETS

### Myanmar

Ramadhan Food Aid Sets were distributed in Mayan Kampum Pandanor Siti Ayawadi Division, Myanmar. **100** sets of basic food items such as rice, sugar, cooking oil, flour, eggs and others were distributed to the poor families. These food packs benefited people of different age groups.

The beneficiaries were contented to be receiving help this Ramadhan. Thank you, sponsors and contributors for bringing joy to them!



### Sri Lanka

In Sri Lanka, **175** Food Aid Sets were distributed in Upparu, Kinniya, Trincomalee. This benefited the less fortunate, poor and needy from various age groups. Another batch of **250** Ramadhan Food Aid Sets were given to the villagers in Kinniya. With the help of all sponsors, the beneficiaries were beyond delighted to be receiving these food sets.







## Singapore

The Ramadhan Charity Drive is an annual event to provide food hampers for the less-fortunate families in Singapore. Over 80 volunteers helped out to sort, pack and distribute the hampers islandwide, which consisted of non-perishable food items such as rice, canned food, salt and sugar. We collaborated with Al-Amin mosque and Mujahidin mosque. Alhamdulillah, **300** beneficiaries received the food hampers, and also bottles of Eid cookies sponsored by our donors.

### Malaysia

## Singapore

Ramadhan is a great time for people to get together with their loved ones. It was a public mass iftar cum kindness day event at Al-Amin- Mosque. **500** cups of ice-cream and **500** trays of Nasi Briyani from Hassan Rabit were served during iftar to the general public, staff, volunteers and support groups who came.

## Rohingya

Our Rohingya brothers and sisters were also not forgotten. Thousands of Rohingya families are facing hunger and struggling to survive at the refugee camps in Bangladesh. They are still living in dire circumstances.

With your contributions, our team managed to distribute **300** Ramadhan food aid packs to families for sahur and iftar, which benefitted **2000** people. In Bangladesh's Cox Bazaar, **500** nutritious Iftar meals distributed to the most needy community at camp 7, Pun Bazar, Balukali, a refugee camp for displaced Rohingyans. For cooked meals, a total of **2000** meals were prepared and served to the recipients. Other contributions include **60,000** litres of water tankers, a new school for the children

and **120** sets of Eid clothes were also distributed for Rohingya children. These children are from Rohingya families who have lost everything, left everything and came here with nothing. Alhamdulillah with your donations they are given nice clothes to wear.





## MIDDLE EAST

### IFTAR PROGRAMME

#### Syrian Refugees

There are more than a million refugees stranded there in Turkey struggling to survive. **500** iftar meal sets were distributed to the Syrian refugees, widows and orphans included in Sanliurfa, Turkey. Iftar for **500** Syrian refugees in Sanliurfa, Turkey, was done on the last few weeks of Ramadhan. As much as we are busy last Ramadhan, they are also busy finding basic supplies for their own family.







One of our projects this past Ramadhan was the setting up of a school for these Syrian refugee children in Jordan. Our Global Ehsan Team managed to witness the opening of the school. It is located at Ad-Dafyanah Refugee Camp, benefitting about **65** students, aged 6-12 years old, from over **70** families. Alhamdulillah, they also have new uniforms and are now able to get a good education all year round.





## **FOOD AID SETS**

Other than witnessing the opening of the new school for Syrian refugees in Jordan, our team also did a Ramadhan Food Aid distribution in Sanliurfa, Turkey. The food aid sets were given to the poor and needy people to support a family for a whole month. The Syrian refugees were thrilled to receive the food sets as it consist of staple food items like canned food and cooking oil. This Ramadhan could have been their best one due to your contributions! **105** food sets were distributed in Ad-Dafyanah and **45** sets in Sabha RCs.







With the help of our partners - Islamic Help - they visited the children for a Kindness Day event and Eid Gift distribution. These beautiful children were treated to delicious ice cream and were also given toys to bring a little cheer and happiness in their lives.

## Gaza

With the assistance of our partners there, we managed to implement the Iftar Meals Sponsorship in Gaza, providing iftar meals for **800** people and also distributed Food aid sets for **100** families. Each set contains enough essential food aid to feed a family of 5-6 for a month and provide them the means to enjoy their iftar and sahur. Your contributions allowed these muslims to fully enjoy the month despite the crippling siege.







As you might have known, bread is a staple food that the people in Gaza have. Last week, **100** families benefited from the bread distribution in Gaza City. The poor and needy elderly, children and adults were delighted to receive food this Ramadhan, as seen from their joyful faces.



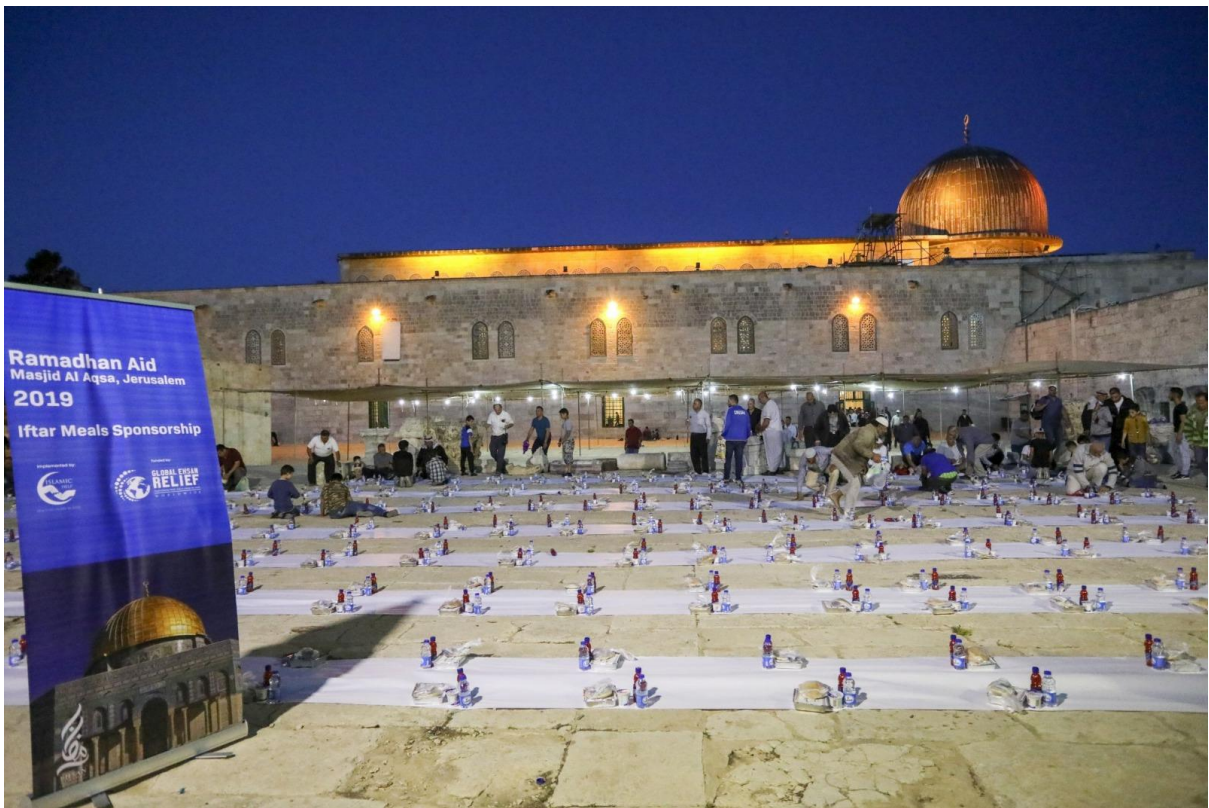
