

AYU WULANDARI'S STORY

“After receiving support from Global Ehsan Relief here in Mahad, our lives have changed 360 degrees.”

Ayu Wulandari, 15 years-old, is the youngest sister among two. Her sister is just one year older than her and is currently studying in senior high school. To fulfil their daily needs, their mother Iyah works as a daily worker.

Iyah works odd jobs such as being a cook assistant, stall seller and working at the laundry shop just to ensure that she earns enough money to continue providing education for her children. Iyah's husband, Ayu's beloved father, passed away a few years back and left them nothing behind but a small, wooden house.



While the living condition of the family is not desirable and at times they struggle with other economic factors, there is a glimmer of hope for the family through Ayu's education. Alhamdulillah Ayu is currently studying in Mahad Ibnu Sina Global Ehsan Relief, Grade IX. She has successfully passed the basic exam to enter the school back in June 2021.

"I have been studying here for two years, but only after Global Ehsan Relief's support and funding, I can live a student life that I dreamed of, like the ones I've seen in the movie. Our school has been nicely refurbished, our toilet has been fixed.

The mosque, the food, the curriculum, everything has changed for the better. May Allah bless all donors and grant them rizq to help other schools like ours. I am so grateful for all this, very very grateful. Thank you."

THE KRAYAT ALHMAYAN'S STORY

MOBILE SCHOOLS IN JORDAN

Our two Mobile Schools in Jordan are crucial in providing the Syrian refugee children living there with the much-needed **access to quality education**.

"Before this, these children had very little knowledge and there are a lot of things that they don't know. So firstly we taught them order, arrangement & attention. Everything you learnt in school,"

"You can see for yourself how much these students progressed, after all the effort and tiring days. Alhamdulillah we have given them all the support they need. We teach them Islamic knowledge, reading, general knowledge, which are all the basic knowledge that is important. We also teach them mathematics and English."



With passionate and big-hearted teachers like Ms Thekayat guiding the children, we at Global Ehsan Relief have high hopes for the future of the mobile school in Jordan.

We pray that the school will continue to reach out to and benefit as many refugee children as possible and empower them with knowledge.

Ms Thekayat ended with this valuable sentiment that we believe is important when serving the community:

“I see no difference between a Syrian or a Jordanian or a refugee. I treat all these children like my own siblings, like my little brothers.”

CARE FOR CLEAN WATER

TOTAL BENEFICIARIES

According to the WHO, over half the global population (4.2 billion people) lack access to sanitation. Globally, at least 2 billion people use drinking water sources that have been contaminated.

Poor sanitation also contaminates drinking-water sources such as rivers. As people wash their clothing, gather water and cook using the same water source, spreading deadly diseases among the wider population.



A major cause of deaths in developing countries with large rural communities like Cambodia and Bangladesh comes from consuming contaminated water sources.

Through our Care for Clean Water campaign, in 2021 alone we have provided crucial access to clean water to over 14,000 beneficiaries. Our work in building water wells in Asia such as Cambodia, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka and Myanmar have borne tremendous impact for the communities living in difficult conditions.

SAJARAH'S STORY

KAMPONG CHAM PROVINCE, CAMBODIA

In her family, Sajarah is the most important person. She is the one in her family that fetches water for their daily use. Before Sajarah and her family received access to safe water from our community water well project, the water crisis affected her everyday since she was young. From childhood to her 30s, Sajarah's primary responsibility was to collect the water her family needed to survive as they could not afford a long-term, accessible water solution for their home.

Together with her daughter and the women and girls of her village, Sajarah travelled long distances each day to collect water. With the new community water well that was built, Sajarah's family and her community are now able to get much-needed clean water easily. "This community water well has changed our lives for the better and we are able to lead a happy and healthier life," Sajarah expressed.

From now on, Sajarah, her daughter and the women and girls in the village no longer have to travel long distances to collect water. The children no longer miss school because of illness or as a result of travelling far just to collect water. Additionally, the community now has enough clean water to use for other domestic chores as well as for ibadah. Alhamdulillah, this is all made possible through your generous and continued support.

Sadaqah Jariyah is an act of giving in a way that keeps on giving. It is an ongoing form of charity that has long-lasting effects that benefits even a whole community. **Waqf** is a sadaqah jariyah - it is a sustainable, ongoing charitable endowment to a religious, educational or charitable cause.

The reward for building a mosque is great and continuous - for every prayer said inside a mosque that you have helped build, Allah s.w.t will reward you in Jannah.



The community in which you have helped build the mosque will also continuously benefit, hence it is an excellent form of Sadaqah Jariyah (continuous charity). There are many of our brothers and sisters living in developing countries and in a much more under-privileged condition than us who struggle without having a proper mosque in their communities. Together with our international partners, we build new mosques and carry out reconstruction on damaged mosques in several countries.

Many people, especially orphans do not have the opportunity to learn about the Al-Quran or Islam, due to the lack of resources. As a result of this, their knowledge of the religion and the Quran is minimal. Global Ehsan Relief aims to change this by providing wakaf Quran to Muslims in underprivileged communities.

With new technology, the Quran is more accessible to all. Our Wakaf Quran Digital Braille aims to assist those who are visually impaired to read, learn and memorise the Quran. In Ramadhan 2021, 500 Quran braille mushafs were given to the community in Yogyakarta and Jakarta. With the generous contributions of our donors, they each now own a Quran Braille that can help them read, recite, and memorise the beautiful verses.

The effects of the COVID-19 have been damaging. For the second year in a row, the COVID-19 pandemic has left a long-lasting impact on the lives of people worldwide.

In war-torn countries like Yemen, Gaza, Palestine, Syria and Afghanistan, their struggles with prolonged internal conflict are exacerbated by the pandemic. The people have had to bear dire consequences, suffering extreme food water, shelter and medical shortages - all while being displaced from their homes.



In India, a country badly hit by the pandemic, our aid of food packs, medical packs and oxygen tanks saved the lives of 1,750 beneficiaries. While in Lebanon, food aid packs and cooked meals are distributed to the Lebanese people and Syrian refugees who are currently struggling as a result of the country's financial crisis.

With the continued support of our GER community, we have continued to provide urgent humanitarian aid to the people who are battling each day to survive.

GLOBAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE

TOTAL BENEFICIARIES

A part of our work revolves around responding to emergencies and being prepared to provide relief when disasters strike. In early 2021, a 6.2-magnitude earthquake struck Indonesia's Sulawesi island, killing 81 people and leaving more than 800 people injured. And by the end of 2021, thousands of people were displaced in Semeru, following a deadly volcano eruption.

Thousands of families have lost their homes, livelihoods and some, even their loved ones, and they relied heavily on humanitarian aid to survive. Thanks to the contributions of our donors, our teams on the ground in Indonesia were able to swiftly provide urgent relief with delivery of essential items.



Nearing the end of year, we saw one of the most catastrophic flood disasters happening in Malaysia. The floods not only destroyed their homes, but also the livelihoods of the victims. Despite the conditions, our Malaysian team braved the worst hit areas in Temerloh and Mentakab district, Pahang to hand-deliver the emergency aid to displaced residents.

Alhamdulillah with the immense support from our community, our team in Malaysia were able to send emergency aid to the victims. We also rendered help to flood victims in Sri Lanka, Indonesia, Gaza and Syria.

In late November, our Global Ehsan Relief teams from Singapore and Malaysia were able to personally deliver the first rounds of distribution for our Winter Emergency Appeal campaign. Together with Global Ehsan Relief's international partners, our team was on the ground, distributing urgent aid such as food aid packs, blankets, winter clothing, heating materials, bread and hot meals to refugees.

In total our teams has given refugees braving the cold more than 7,000 cooked meals. Our hot meals were delivered to thousands of hungry families in Jordan, Lebanon, Turkey, Gaza, Yemen, Syria and Bangladesh.

AHMET'S STORY

NAMIK KEMA, KAHRAMANMARAS, TURKEY

Our teams met Ahmet's family. Ahmet's family has been living in Turkey since 2013, after fleeing their home in Idlib, Syria 8 years ago. Although they've been living there for close to a decade, Ahmet is still unable to find a job because his citizenship application has not yet been accepted.

Ahmet has been left to care for his 10 children (5 daughters and 5 sons) on just 200 to 700 lira per month (USD53), barely enough to pay for basic necessities and electricity. His youngest child is just three years old.

Your donations have helped ensure they have cooked meals, a food aid pack, winter clothing and blankets for the harsh winter, so that the family can focus what little money they have on electricity, which will help keep their heater running through cold nights.

Thank you for helping a father care for his children.

COVID-19 EMERGENCY RELIEF

Another year of the COVID-19 pandemic has affected thousand of families and individuals around the world. Many have been driven to homelessness and hunger, lost their livelihoods, are facing financial distress and became even more exposed to the growing pandemic.

Since its outbreak at the end of 2019, the COVID-19 pandemic has brought about huge losses - both in its mortality rates as well as economic consequences - all over the world. The pandemic has pushed people further down the poverty line. People who were struggling before the pandemic, struggled even more. People who were surviving well before the pandemic, were now struggling as well.



Unfortunately for those already living below the poverty line, they face new and deepened poverty as a result of COVID-19. For these individuals, hardship is a daily reality.

In the blessed month of Rabi'ul-Awwal - to commemorate our beloved Prophet Muhammad S.A.W and his love for orphans - GER gave out a total of 700 food aid packs that helped feed more than 3,500 orphans and widows in Indonesia, Cambodia, Sri Lanka, Myanmar and Malaysia.

In Aceh, our team distributed a total of 500 cooked meals to the orphans there. Thanks to our donors, they are able to eat well for at least another month without risking their health and safety.



2021 also saw us launching our 6th year of Ehsan Ramadhan! In 2021 alone, we distributed Ramadhan Food Aid Packs to more than 25 countries worldwide, reaching more than 22,000 beneficiaries.

200 food packs were distributed in Desa Ulee Ue, Bireun District where most of the beneficiaries were the elderly, widows and many who have been left unemployed due to the COVID pandemic. This is the first time that residents of Desa Ulee Ue have received food aid, and they are thankful to those who have contributed to it.

While in Zulhijjah, we carried out Qurban in 35 countries worldwide, benefitting more than 270,000 beneficiaries. Our GER community shared their blessings with our brothers and sisters who need it the most in the less fortunate countries. If not for the donated Qurban of our generous donors, these individuals might not have a chance to eat meat at all for the year.

In Syria, more than 3,500 Syrian refugees in the Harbanush and Maretmesrin camps in Idlib were able to enjoy fresh meat. In Malawi, more than 5,000 people benefited from the Qurban donations.

FATIMA'S STORY

Ms Fatimah, 80, is a recipient of our Ramadhan Food Aid pack that our donors have generously donated. Living alone in Chroy Metrey Ler village in the Kandal province of Cambodia, she walks long hours from morning till afternoon to collect scrap metal.

Despite her hard labour, she only earns between \$3.50 to \$5 every few days. She received the food aid with tears in her eyes, expressing gratitude, because each day is a struggle for her to find food to eat.






INCOME

In 2021, we raised \$3.7mil (2020: \$3.2mil) representing about 14% increase from the prior year. See chart on the right.

This year, we experience an exponential growth in our income due to the effectiveness of the fundraising campaigns within the community in Singapore.







