EMERGENCY RELIEF

Syrian conflict has created the worst humanitarian crisis of our time. More than 250,000 Syrians have lost their lives in 4 ½ years. More than 11 million others have been forced from their home.



Families are struggling to survive inside Syria, or make a new home in neighboring countries. Others are risking their lives on the way to Europe, hoping to find acceptance and opportunity. And harsh winters and hot summers make life as a refugee even more difficult. At times, the effects of the conflict can seem overwhelming.



More than seven years of economic crisis have brought the Palestinian economy in a verge of collapse. Living levels have dropped considerably and levels of poverty, deprivation and unemployment are increasing rapidly throughout the territories. A majority of Palestinians, 67%, live below the income poverty line valued as \$2, and about half of them 39 %, live in extreme poverty.

The terrible toll on civilians is shocking. Hospitals and water supplies are under massive strain and the needs are increasing by the day. The bad economic and social situation in Gaza has multiplied the poverty rate to its highest level. Water, food and electricity shortages has become worse.



All of that is an important reason to why we are going to implement various projects and helping as many people as we can, by sponsorship to the most needy families, and give them a better health and living environment.

Orphanage

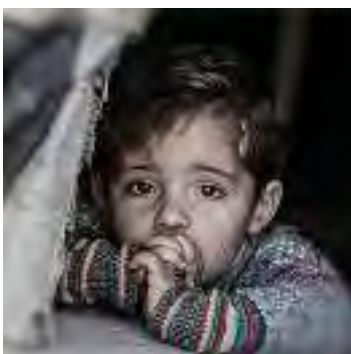
Our mission is to deliver aid and development programmes to those who need it most in an efficient and effective way without prejudice to people's religion, sex, age or ethnic background. Over 100,000 orphans worldwide are currently in need of support to ensure that they finish school and have enough money for food, healthcare and household necessities.

This project aims to improve the living conditions of orphans and to organise social activities for orphans and their families. Orphans receive clothes, school bags and books, notebooks and other school materials.



An orphan in Islam is defined as a child who has lost his father or both of his parents. In Arabic, an orphan is called a yateem. The number of young children being orphaned is increasing: families torn apart through war, poverty, hunger and disease. Exploitation and abuse are rife. The world sees the problem in its vastness. We see millions of individuals each being denied a future with opportunities.

Alhamdulillah, Global Ehsan Relief together with its international partners supports thousands of orphans, helping safeguard their iman and providing them a chance where there one was not.



WAQAF WATER WELL & HAND PUMP

Water Projects

From an Islamic perspective, wakaf water/ hand pumps, begins with a noble intention to do good deeds for the benefit of oneself and other. Many people in the developing world rely on open water sources that have no cover. An unsealed water source means water becomes dirty and contaminated, leading to the spread of disease.



In more flat fertile areas, such as parts of South and East Asia, hand pumps are ideal for villages and households. Surface sources are common, so only a basic pump suffices for poor families trying to meet their water requirements.

Suction hand pumps are cheap, easy to install and maintain. Maintenance is done at the village level without the need for specialist parts. The maximum column of water the pump can physically lift is approximately 7m. The pumps are made from cast iron.



Water hand pumps are very simple and small gifts, empowering vulnerable women and children by giving them dignity in accessing water. Particularly in many countries, women and children can spend many hours fetching water from nearby sources, sometimes walking up to 2-3 kilometres in search of drinking water.

General Expenditure 2015



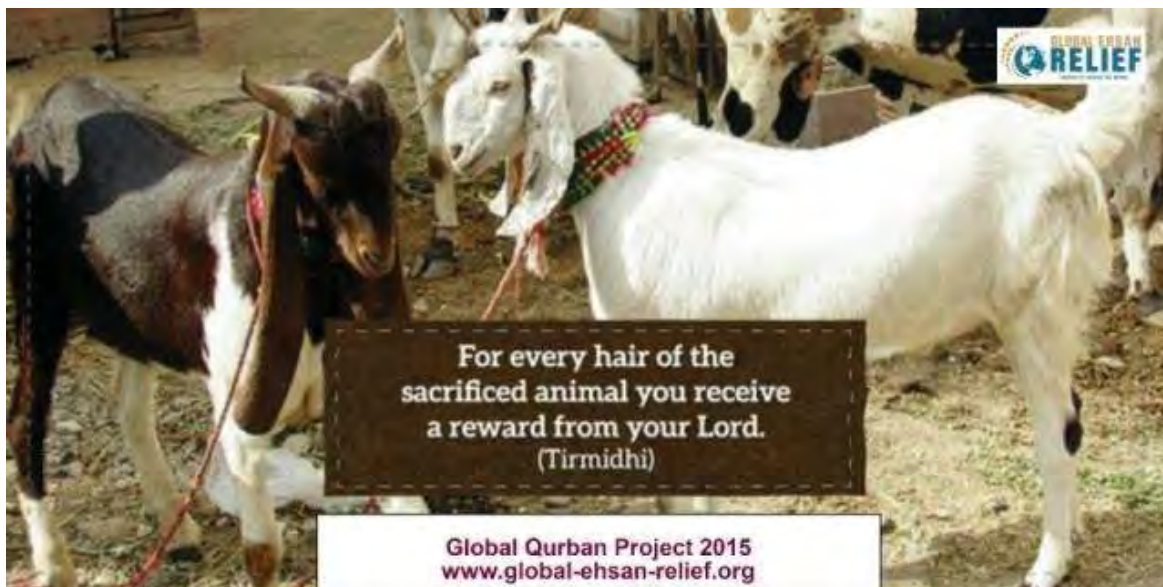

GLOBAL QURBAN 2015

Millions of people sleep hungry every day, with children the worst affected. Without the means for even basic food, meat is an absolute luxury and many go months, even years without meat.

In 2015 Global Ehsan Relief implemented Overseas Qurban during Hari Raya Haji. In various countries like Cambodia, Syria, Somaliland, Ghana, Gaza, Palestine, Myanmar, Rohingya, Sudan, Malawi/India, Yemen and Australia.



We ensure the most needy people receive the best Qurban we can provide them as only healthy animals are selected, ensuring the high quality meat. As well as delivering in highly populated towns and cities, we also provide Qurban in remote, rural areas, where communities hardly ever receive support. It may be slightly more expensive to reach these areas, but it ensures that the poorest people receive help – women, children, the elderly, and refugees of war and disaster are always our priority.
