Care For Orphans

Our Orphan Sponsorship programme allows donors to look after the welfare and care for orphans around the world.

A monthly or annual sponsorship for a single orphan will ensure their needs are met - including food, shelter, health, and education.

To date, we have 878 orphans under the care of our generous donors, 557 from which also undergo special hifz Qur'an lessons led by experienced Qur'an teachers throughout the duration of the sponsorship.

Care For Hunger

- Annual Food Program

To help combat hunger, our Annual Food Program serves to provide meals and basic food necessities to families in Gaza. Due to the adversity they have faced for years, they are in constant need of humanitarian aid. The Jumuah Meals program provides 20 families with a food platter every Friday. Each family receives a platter large enough for them to share and enjoy together. In this quarter, 160 meals were distributed in the months of April and May.

The Monthly Food Voucher program allows families to pick and choose their groceries and household needs at the local grocery store with the vouchers provided for them. A total of 90 vouchers were given to 45 families in the months of April and May.

Care For Hunger

- Weekly Bread Distribution

In addition to the above-mentioned programs, 200 families in Gaza also receive 50 loaves of bread each week. This ensures that they have enough food to last throughout the week. Through this distribution, 1000 beneficiaries can rest assured that they won't go hungry.



- Cooked Meals Distribution

Providing meals is a crucial part of our Care for Hunger projects. World hunger is on the rise, with 690 million people in the world going to bed hungry each night.

We do our part by providing cooked meals to those who are caught in this situation. A total of 5,000 meals were delivered to the most vulnerable in Bangladesh, Pakistan, and Rohingya Refugee camps.

Care For Education

- Ehsan Education Fund

The 'Ehsan Education Fund' was established to help support the operations of schools around the world. In this quarter, this project helped support Mahed Nur, a Syrian girls' education centre in Idlib, Syria. 150 refugee girls (most of whom are orphans) are able to continue receiving their education because of this school. On top of that, we began supporting the School in a Bus project in Lebanon. The bus travels to remote areas in the Bekaa Refugee Camp, ensuring Syrian refugee children are able to attend school.



- Meals For Education

To help support underprivileged children thrive in their education, we also provide meals for students in Sri Lanka. Research has found that children who are well-fed and not hungry will positively affect their individual performance in school. For 3 months, 150 students receive free meal packs 3 times each week.

Care For Clean Water

Families living in poverty often have very limited access to clean water. Our Care for Clean Water projects serve as a solution for their daily water needs.

We build wells and ablution places so that families and communities have ease of access to clean water.

Lasting up to a decade or more, these sources of clean water are also a source of relief for those living in rural areas. They no longer have to walk long distances to the nearest clean water source.


On top of constructing structures that pump water from the ground, 150 families in Gaza receive a supply of clean water each month, stored in water tanks placed in their own homes.

- Mosque

This quarter saw the completion and grand openings of four new mosques. All located in different countries in Africa, these poverty-stricken countries often lack the resources to build facilities for their communities.

Alhamdulillah, with the opening of these new mosques, 2,850 people in rural Africa have new amenities to use for worship, learning, and building the community.

Global Wakaf Projects

- Qur'an

In Ramadhan, 5,865 wakaf Qur'an were distributed in six different countries. In these countries, they face a shortage of supply in copies of the Qur'an. To import them would be expensive, and to print their own would not be feasible. With the donated Mushafs, students in various schools and institutions now have their own copies of the Qur'an to recite, read, and memorise from.



- Digital Qur'an Braille

In addition to the wakaf Qur'an, we also distributed wakaf braille Qur'an digital to beneficiaries in Indonesia. They were donated to institutions for the visually impaired who have been learning to recite and understand the Qur'an, but have not been able to afford to obtain more copies of a Qur'an Braille which tend to be costly.

Global Emergency Appeal

- Palestine

At the end of May 2021, Palestine was faced with a major emergency. A conflict broke out, which severely affected the population. The city was faced with large-scale destruction, and homes were destroyed leaving thousands homeless. Food and water supplies were cut off, and medical services were overwhelmed.

With the swift response of our donors and partners, we were able to step in and provide the critical aid needed. This included food aid, monetary hand-outs, as well as household and personal needs.

To help medical services cope with the influx of medical emergencies and admitted patients, we provided hospital beds, fuel for the local hospital, and a mobile clinic to attend to less urgent cases.

Global Emergency Appeal

- India

The entire world is still reeling from and adapting to the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic. However, the situation in India worsened especially in the months of April and May. With more than 400,000 deaths reported to date, they have been facing an ongoing healthcare crisis.

In response to this emergency, we helped to provide essential aid to families affected in terms of food aid packs, and medical packs. 50 oxygen tanks were also delivered to multiple hospitals in Delhi to help them cope with the rising number of COVID-19 cases they were treating.



- Sri Lanka (Covid-19 Emergency Relief)

In our efforts to provide relief during the COVID-19 pandemic, we offered our aid to families in Sri Lanka who have been affected. With economies affected, jobs lost, and inflated prices on food, many are struggling to make ends meet.

500 food packs were distributed in different villages of the Trincomalee district. 100 baby milk was also distributed to ensure children aren't deprived of essential nutrients. 100 hygiene kits were given to help families ensure personal hygiene and cleanliness within their homes.

Ramadhan saw our highest number of distributions, benefitting the most number of people in this quarter.

Food aid packs and iftar meals were given out to help ease the burden of finding food throughout the month.

Eid gifts and meals as well as meat packs were shared to celebrate the festivities. Zakat was disbursed to the eligible asnaf in six countries.

In the blessed month of Ramadhan, with the help of generous donors and hardworking partners, we touched the lives of more than 54,000 people.

He and his mother and two other siblings live in a small, dilapidated wooden hut. They live in dire conditions, and struggle each day to make ends meet. However, through the orphan sponsorship, things are looking a bit better.

His mother tells us, "At least my worries about his education fee eased a little. With the money I get every month from the donors, I could pay for his school fee, buy his uniform, books and all of his school materials."
