CARE FOR ORPHANS ORPHAN SPONSORSHIP

Our Care for Orphans sponsorship programme has been around since 2015. Through this programme, donors make a monthly sponsorship that will provide orphans with food, shelter, clothes, healthcare, and an education. In this quarter, we have increased the total number of orphans sponsored to 973.

614 of them are Hifz orphans who also undergo a Hifz Qur'an programme, where they aim to memorise the Qur'an within 5 years or more. 359 of them are orphans who receive regular sponsorship. These orphans come from all over the world, including Aceh, Jogja, Sri Lanka, Gaza, Cambodia, Bangladesh, New Delhi, Senegal, and more. We hope to hit the 1,000 mark milestone in the month of Rabiul-Awwal.

CARE FOR HUNGER ANNUAL FOOD PROGRAM

To help alleviate hunger in Gaza, our Annual Food Program provides meals and basic food necessities through our Jumaah Meals and Monthly Food Voucher programmes. 20 families receive a food platter every Friday, large enough for them to share and enjoy together. We distributed 160 meals in total in the past few months.

The Monthly Food Voucher program allows families to use vouchers to pick and choose their groceries and household needs at the local grocery store. A total of 90 vouchers were given to 45

CARE FOR HUNGER BREAD DISTRIBUTION

Bread is a staple food for Palestinians, and as part of our Care for Hunger projects, we distribute bread to 200 families in Gaza each week.

This ensures that they have enough food to last throughout the entire week, and eventually receive a top-up of their staple food for the following week. 1,000 people benefit from this project every week.

CARE FOR HUNGER FOOD AID PACKS

World hunger is on the rise, with 690 million people in the world going to bed hungry each night. To help combat world hunger, we provide food aid packs to needy and vulnerable families in poor countries to ensure that they aren't deprived of food.

The food packs are tailored to the cuisine of each country, and includes staple pantry items that can last from three to four weeks. A total of 350 food aid packs were delivered in this quarter to Cambodia and Indonesia, thus benefiting 1,750 people.

CARE FOR CLEAN WATER 4 WATER PROJECTS

Communities that are stricken by poverty often have very limited access to clean water. Our Care for Clean Water projects serve as a solution for their daily water needs. We build structures such as water wells and ablution places that can pump water from the ground for ease of access to clean water.

In the months of July to September, we built 189 water wells, 24 community water wells, and 18 ablution places across Cambodia, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, and Myanmar. These structures can last up to a decade or more, giving more than 4,000 individuals a constant source of clean water in the many years to come.

Additionally, we also provide water tanks to 150 families in Gaza and supply it with 1000 litres of clean water each month via water truck. This is the best solution provided for Gazans, as the water in Palestinian grounds have been contaminated, and pumping water from the ground would only harm the consumers.







CARE FOR EDUCATION

At Global Ehsan Relief, we believe that every child has the right to an education. We advocate this right by building schools, employing teachers, and providing students with everything they need to ensure the smooth running of the classrooms.

170 Syrian refugee girls are able to continue receiving their education by attending Mahed Nur, an education centre funded by our Ehsan Education Fund.

To aid with the education of underprivileged children in rural Cambodia, we distributed 150 stationery sets to 150 students. This includes backpacks, notebooks, and school shoes.

GLOBAL WAKAF PROJECTS MOSQUE

This quarter saw the completion and grand openings of four new mosques. Baitul Muttaqin was built in the village of Blang Pidie in Aceh, Indonesia with the funds collected from our Wakaf a Prayer Space project.

Masjid An-Nur is the fourth masjid we have opened in Tanzania, and Masjid Hj Abdul Jalal is the second masjid we have built in Cameroon. Meanwhile, we have also built our first mosque in Mozambique, called Masjid Az-Zahra.

With the new mosques built, we have created a safe space for more than 2,000 Muslims in underdeveloped countries who can use the mosques in their hometowns for many years into the future.

Alhamdulillah, a new school has been built in rural Cambodia. This school is located at Phnom Pir village, Chloung district, Kratie province. Ma'had Al-Ehsan is the 3rd school to be opened in Cambodia, giving 150 students a conducive environment for learning and studying. During the grand opening ceremony of the school, there was also a distribution of 50 food aid packs and 150 school materials.

We continue to provide wakaf Qur'an and have donated them to various schools, institutions, and mosques around Jakarta and Aceh in Indonesia. A total of 780 copies of the Qur'an were distributed in this quarter. Some institutions that received this donation include Madrasah Ibtidayah Nurul Iman in Jakarta, Raudhatul Ilmi in Aceh Timur, Dayah Nurul Iman in Aceh Utara and more.





GLOBAL EMERGENCY RELIEF COVID-19

As the world continues to recover from a worldwide pandemic, we continue to send aid to those most affected by it. The COVID-19 pandemic has drastically and irreversibly affected the lives of those less fortunate. With job losses, inflation of prices, and disruptions to the global supply chains, many poor families have had to live with even less than they usually do.

Our offices in Indonesia and Malaysia, with the collaboration and funding from Islamic Help, distributed a variety of items which have benefited individuals, households, and even hospitals. In India, we distributed food aid and meals in conjunction with Eid al-Adha. In Cambodia and Sri Lanka, more food aid was distributed to help tide the families over during this difficult time.

Through this emergency response, 10,300 beneficiaries received some form of aid to ease their burden.



GLOBAL EMERGENCY APPEAL LEBANON

Lebanon is currently faced with a financial crisis that is severely affecting its residents. With unemployment rising, prices skyrocketing, and goods becoming scarce, the situation has left thousands hungry and lacking basic needs.

In response to this emergency, we distributed 5,000 meals over 5 days to the Lebanese people and Syrian refugees. 250 food aid packs were also distributed, giving them the assurance that they'll have food to eat amid this turmoil.

GLOBAL EMERGENCY APPEAL SYRIA

We have not forgotten our brothers & sisters who have been displaced and severely affected by the conflict that has been going on for more than 10 years. As part of our Syria Emergency Relief, we distributed aid to Syrian internally displaced persons (IDPs) in Idlib, Syria and Syrian refugees in Turkey this quarter.

Food baskets include dry food items and fresh ingredients for their daily consumption, of which 400 were distributed in total. Bread, a staple food item, was distributed in tonnes for all residents of the camps. Other items include cooked meals, baby milk, and hygiene kits. All of which are basic necessities that they lack in their respective camps.

GLOBAL EMERGENCY APPEAL YEMEN

Ten years on, the conflict in Yemen wages on, leaving behind a catastrophic humanitarian crisis amid its people. Millions of IDPs are solely relying on humanitarian aid to survive. This quarter, we distributed aid such as meals, baby milk, food aid packs, hygiene kits and clean water.

Alhamdulillah, with the help of The Water Bender (an individual fundraiser committed to bringing clean water to poverty-stricken countries), we managed to secure sponsorship of clean water for the whole year. The clean water is hauled in water trucks that is then supplied to water tanks all throughout cities and refugee camps, allowing everyone to access clean water with ease.

GLOBAL EMERGENCY APPEAL PALESTINE

Earlier in this quarter, Palestine was struck with adversity yet again when airstrikes hit homes and sacred places of worship. Many were left homeless, seeking refuge in schools. Their homes have turned into mere rubble.

Despite the chaos and calamity, our brave GER ground team in Gaza continued with their efforts to provide relief to families who have been displaced.

As the conflict arose just days before the end of Ramadhan, we provided Iftar meals, as well as Eid meals and gifts for those afflicted. Food packs were distributed to ensure they have food to eat after having lost everything.

For 3 months, almost 1,700 families received a water tanker supplied with a total of 65,000 litres of water, benefitting 8,500 individuals.









GLOBAL EMERGENCY APPEAL AFGHANISTAN

Afghanistan recently saw an upsurge in their internal conflicts, which gave rise to price inflations, food shortages, and a vulnerable healthcare system amid the COVID-19 pandemic. As a result, 18 million people became desperate and reliant on humanitarian aid.

With the quick response of our donors and partners, we rendered aid such as food, water, hygiene kits, blankets, and baby nutrition packs. More than 4,000 people benefited from the aid delivered.

SEASONAL PROJECTS QURBAN

Since 2015, we have operated our Qurban projects in Zulhijjah with the aim to provide the underprivileged with fresh and nutritious Qurban meat. Performed in Asia, Africa, the Middle East, and the Balkans, we work with trusted partners worldwide to ensure that the Qurban is done in accordance with Syariah and the best practices. We also ensure that the slaughtered meat is delivered to the most needy in each country.

This year, more than 3,000 animals were slaughtered, giving 272,650 individuals fresh meat to enjoy their Eid al-Adha with. Distributed to rural and poor areas, the meat is a treat they would otherwise not get to enjoy. We also launched our Qurban for Orphans package, which allowed donors to send humanitarian aid together with their Qurban meat donations. This package includes the donation of 1 cow share and a food aid pack, which can feed the orphan's family for up to a month.

Distributed in various locations in Aceh, 500 orphans received the meat and food aid, for which they are extremely grateful. Some of the distribution locations include: Banda Aceh, Aceh Besar, Tangse, Abdya, Aceh Selatan, Arongan, and more.

LOCAL PROJECTS SINGAPORE

Global Ehsan Relief Singapore goes on monthly distributions, delivering aid for our various core projects. Items distributed include baby needs, elderly needs, grocery hampers, wheelchairs, and monetary aid. Beneficiaries of these projects include babies, single mothers, the disabled, and orphaned families among others.

Some projects, such as Ehsan Baby Care, Care for the Elderly, and Care for the Disabled require special attention due to the beneficiaries' specific needs. Such as the size and type of wheelchair, or brand of diapers and milk. Assessment is done before each distribution to ensure that they receive the items they specifically need.

Care For Orphaned Families

Mdm Halijah, Singapore

Mdm Halijah lost her husband a year ago. She now lives with her 70 year-old father and 12 year-old daughter who has ADHD. In February this year, she was admitted to the hospital for three and a half months, and her left leg had to be amputated.

This surgery came just 4 years after she lost her right leg to an infection as well. Despite her health issues, she continues to manage an online business selling health supplements, crackers, and other small items just to support her family. Especially after the passing of her late husband.

Her family received a care package last month from the Care for Orphaned Families project in Singapore. Each package contained monetary aid and essential groceries to help ease her financial expenses.



Global Wakaf Projects - Baitul Muttaqin Mosque

Ustaz Nadjib Aziz, Aceh, Indonesia

Ustaz Nadjib is a representative of the Ulama Council in Abdya and the head Imam of Masjid Baitul Muttaqin in Blang Pidie, Aceh. His friend, Ustaz Hanafi, had waqaf a piece of land 12 years ago and asked for a mosque to be built there.

But it was a dead end for the longest time because he couldn't find potential donors.

The community in the area is poor and most of them can't afford to build a mosque, resorting instead to walking 5km to the nearest mosque to perform congregational prayers.

After 12 years, Ustaz Nadjib is extremely grateful for the assistance by GER Indonesia for rallying donors and executing the construction project of Masjid Baitul Muttaqin.
