# Global Qurban Project Report 2017 - By Global Ehsan Relief

The sacrifice of Qurban is a highly recommended religious act. The blessed Prophet Muhammad (SAW) ordered each family to do so at least once a year. The normal practice in Islam is for the animals to be slaughtered during Eid-ul- Adha, that is, on every 10th, 11th and 12th of Zulhijjah.

In many countries, the act of Qurban has become a community project that benefits those in the immediate locality. Global Ehsan Relief and with our International partners help to facilitate Muslims in donating their sacrifice to the world's most needy families.

We monitor the 'halal' slaughtering process of the Qurban to ensure the humane treatment of the animals and a healthy meat product. As part of its effort to provide quality food distribution to the world's needy communities, we source livestock according to Islamic specifications. This ensures sustainability, and the selection of non-diseased animals.

Alhamdulillah, with your generous support we were able to distribute over 1000 livestock – which includes cows, goats and camels to the poor, needy and orphans in over 15 countries. Your Qurban contributions this year benefitted more than 25,000 people worldwide.

#### **Purpose of the Project and Expectations:**

- Very poor and needy villages surrounding the major cities who are not being targeted by other NGO's.
